Key Information to Gather for a Comprehensive Rush Resume

Personal Information

- Full name
- Preferred name or nickname
- Contact information (phone number and email address)
- Home address
- Birthdate
- Social media accounts (Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, Instagram)

Academic Details

- High school name, city, state, and ZIP code
- Graduation year
- GPA (weighted and unweighted and scale, if applicable)
- Class size and rank (if available)
- Standardized test scores (SAT, ACT, AP exams, etc.)
- Major or intended field of study

Extracurricular Activities

- Clubs, organizations, and leadership roles
- Sports teams and positions
- Volunteer work or community service
- Performing arts participation (choir, dance, theatre, etc.)
- Other hobbies or interests



Achievements and Awards

- Academic honors or scholarships
- Athletic awards
- Community service recognition
- Other awards or distinctions

Work Experience

- Part-time jobs or internships
- Volunteer positions
- Relevant skills gained from work experience

Personal Interests and Traits

- Favorite hobbies or passions
- Unique talents or skills
- Three words to describe yourself
- Why you are interested in joining a sorority

References

- Names and contact information of teachers, mentors, or employers
- Letters of recommendation (if required)

Additional Information

- Family legacy connections to sororities (sorority and chapter name)
- Any special circumstances or personal stories
- Suggested topics of conversation during rush
- Indication of what type of person to be paired with during rush
